



Dual Enrollment Defined

The purpose of the Dual Enrollment program is to promote and increase access to postsecondary educational opportunities for Georgia high school students while increasing high school graduation rates, preparing a skilled workforce, and decreasing time and cost to postsecondary credential completion.

Georgia's Dual Enrollment Program provides funding for students who are dually enrolled in a participating public high school and postsecondary institution in Georgia.

Students take

for credit towards both high
school graduation
requirements and
postsecondary certificates,
diploma or associate

- Dual Enrollment can provide students with a more flexible schedule
