Blythe Elementary School promotes parental engagement through various events and programs such as:

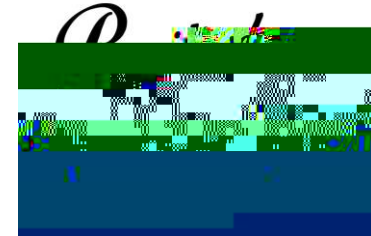
